

RE: Brookshire Sanitary Relief (Brookshire Dr to Cougar Dr) Neighborhood Meeting

**Dear Resident:** 

The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District has engaged the services of Amec Foster Wheeler Environment & Infrastructure, Inc. to design improvements for the above referenced project. This project consists of constructing approximately 4,323 lineal feet of 8-inch to 18-inch diameter sanitary sewer. The general area covered by this project is an area north of Lindbergh Boulevard and west of New Halls Ferry Road in the City of Florissant and unincorporated St. Louis County, Missouri. A map has been attached that indicates the limits of this project.

A neighborhood meeting will be held Monday, May 21, 2018 at 7:00 pm at St. Louis County Library – Jamestown Bluffs Branch, located at 4153 N. Highway 67, Florissant, MO 63034. At the meeting, you can review the plans that show the proposed improvements.
