NOTICE OF PROPOSED SURVEYING WORK

The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) will be studying proposed improvements to the sanitary sewer system in your area. MSD has contracted with AMEC Environment & Infrastructure, Inc. to study and design the proposed improvements. The title of this project is FF-07 Fee Fee Creek Sanitary Relief (Meadowside Dr to Willow Brook Dr) and the Project Number is 10012.

The general area covered by this project is from Crystal Point Circle east to Willow Brook Drive, along the Schuetz Road corridor. Field surveys will be taking place in your neighborhood beginning April 2018 and will last for about three months. The field surveys will be performed by EFK Moen, LLC. The surveying will primarily occur along the route of the existing sewers and/or along the creek channel. They will be measuring the elevations of the houses along the route and may need to enter some houses to obtain accurate measurements of the basement elevations.

Soil borings will also be taken within the project area and are currently scheduled to occur between April and June 2018. The soils investigations will be performed by Kaskaskia Engineering Group, LLC.
