MSD Project Clear (MSDPC) Overview

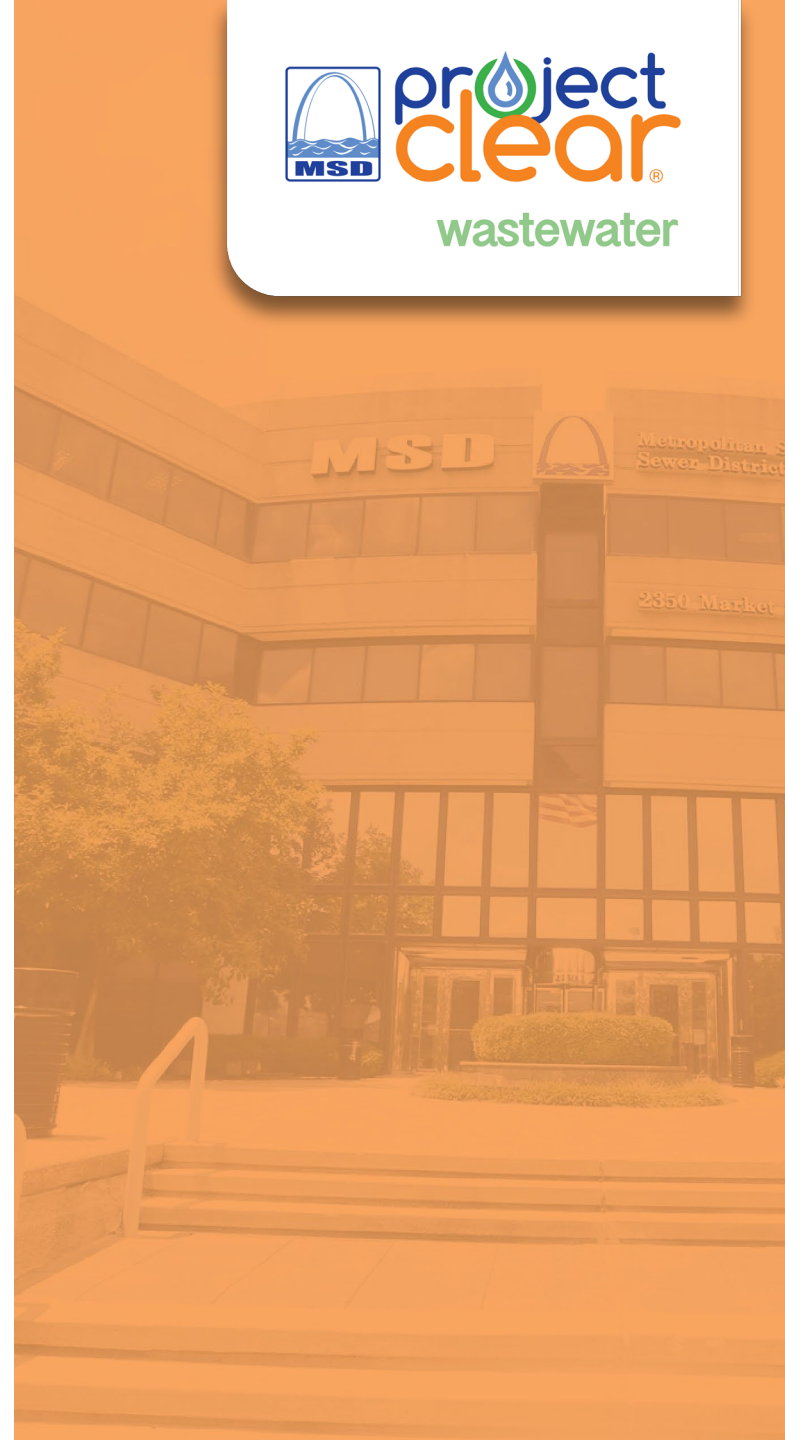
- Government Utility
 - State Constitution
 - Voter Approved Charter in 1954
 - 6 Member Board of Trustees (3 City & 3 County)
- Two utilities: Wastewater & Stormwater
- 520 square mile service area
 - All of St. Louis City
 - 87% of St. Louis County
- ~1,300,000 customers
- 88 municipalities served
- 7 Treatment Plants
- 350+ million gallons per day of wastewater treated
- 4,700+ miles of wastewater sewers
- 1,800+ miles of combined sewers
- 3,000+ miles of stormwater sewers
- 4th largest sewer system in the United States (as measured by miles of sewers handling wastewater)

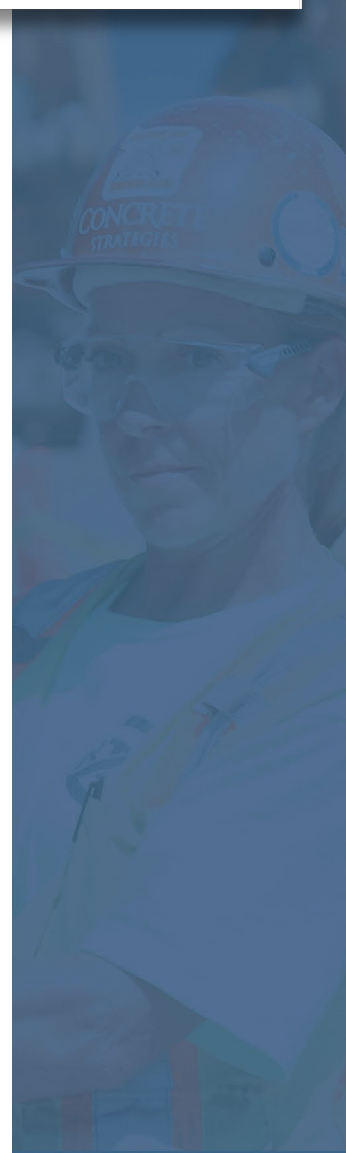

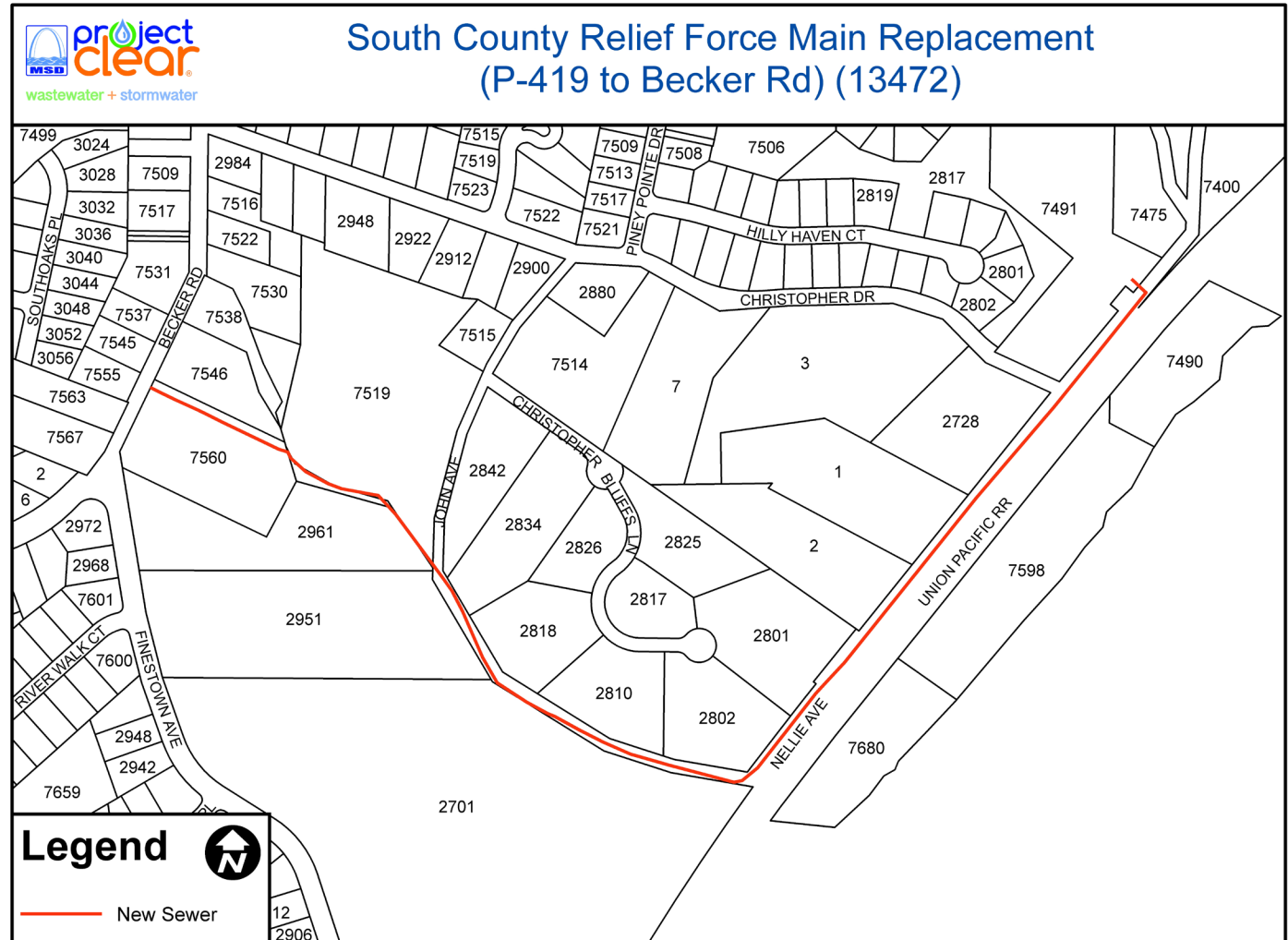
Project Overview

- General Goal
 - Replace deteriorating wastewater pipe
- Project Scope
 - Approximately 4,140 feet of sewer
 - 12" diameter pipe
- Benefits
 - Reduce sewer overflows resulting in cleaner local waterways



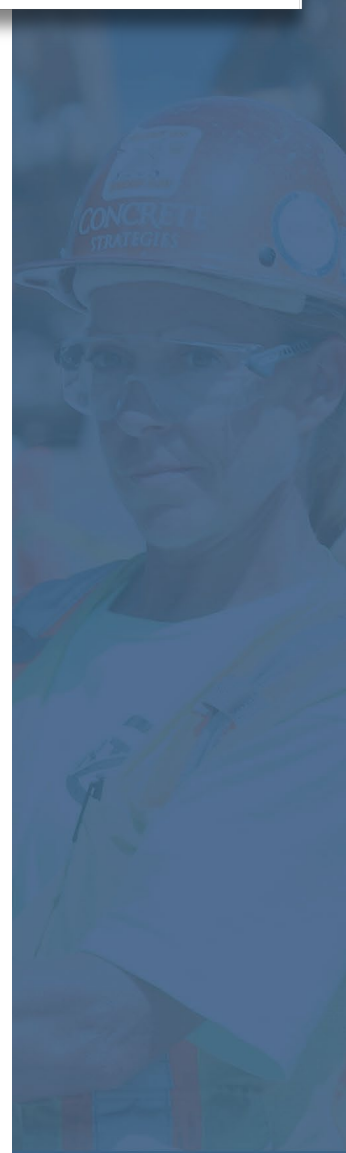

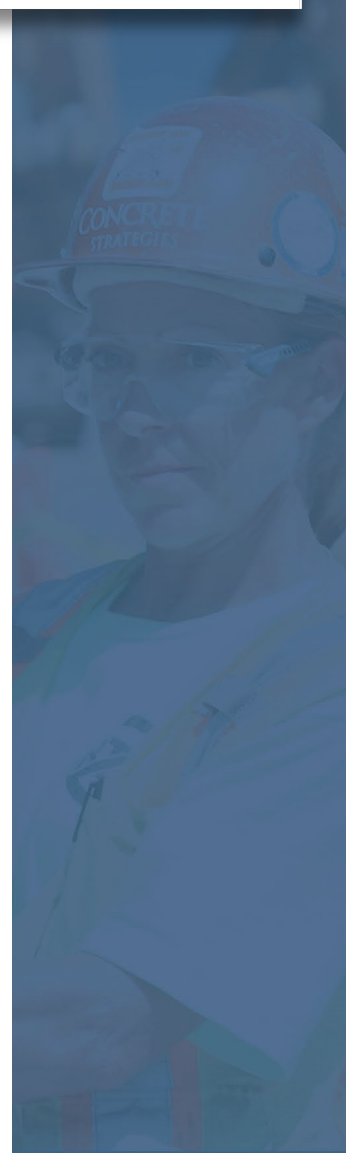

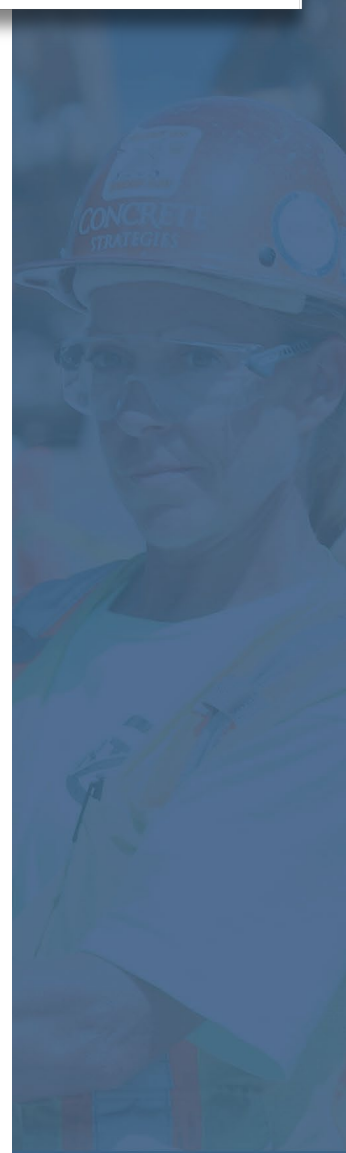
What can residents expect during construction?

- Open-cut construction
 - Rock removal – noise
 - Generators - noise
 - Lane restrictions: Becker Road
 - Driveway access: Christopher Drive



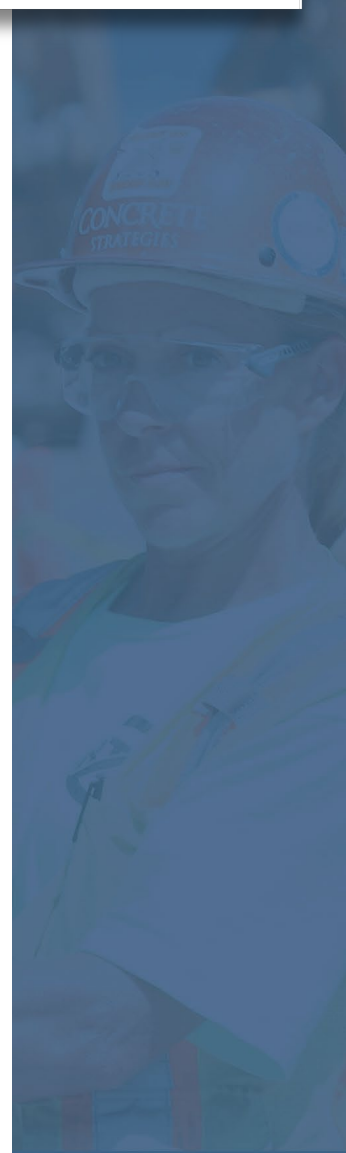
What can residents expect after construction?

- Streets and public areas will be restored in kind
- Trees and shrubs in right of way will not be replaced – contractor will work with arborist
- About 30 trees in the park will be replaced
- Private properties will be restored according to the easement agreements
- Sod and concrete replacement are seasonal and weather dependent
