NOTICE OF PROPOSED SURVEYING WORK

The Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District (MSD) will be studying proposed improvements to the sanitary sewer system and/or stormwater drainage system in your area. MSD has contracted with Wood to study and design the proposed improvements. The title of this project is Sub-Trunk No. 3 Sanitary Relief (Muriel Dr to Jenner Ln) and the Project Number is 11669.

The general area covered by this project is located north of Interstate I-270 and west of Bellefontaine Road in unincorporated St. Louis County, within the Watkins Creek Watershed of Bissell Point Service Area. Field surveys will be taking place in your neighborhood beginning within the next week and will last intermittently for about two months. The field surveys will be performed by EFK Moen, LLC. The surveying will primarily occur along the route of the existing sewers and/or along the creek channel. They will be measuring the elevations of the houses along the route and may need to enter some houses to obtain accurate measurements of the basement elevations.

Soil borings will also be taken within the project area and are currently scheduled to occur during the months of July 2019 through August of 2019. The soils investigations will be performed by Kaskaskia Engineering Group, LLC.
