
## PROPOSITION S - APRIL 2, 2024 STORMWATER



STORMWATER SOLUTIONS POSSIBLE THROUGHOUT THE REGION **PROPOSITION S** will decide whether voters want MSD Project Clear to address growing, region-wide flooding and erosion problems fueled by climate change. There is currently no funding for regional stormwater solutions.

PROPOSITION S is a response to thousands of flooding and erosion problems reported by MSDPC customers. These stormwater problems are already more than the region's natural and constructed stormwater systems can handle. They are also beyond most homeowners' technical and financial capabilities and require the resources of a regional entity, like MSD Project Clear, to resolve.



## PROPOSITION W - APRIL 2, 2024 WASTEWATER



MSD Project Clear is in the midst of a \$7.2 billion, 28-year improvement program through 2039, part of an agreement with EPA and the Missouri Coalition for the Environment. These improvements are on schedule and on budget.

**PROPOSITION W** will decide whether MSDPC will issue bonds, borrowing part of funds needed for the next four years of required wastewater system improvements which will protect more households from sewage backups and more sewage entering creeks and streams, so this question only asks voters how to fund these improvements.
